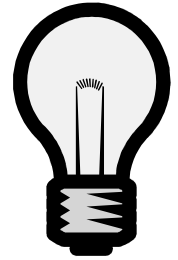

Pupils should be taught to place events and objects in chronological order.

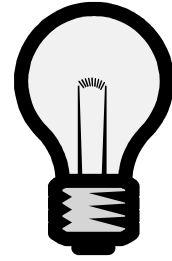
Pupils should be taught to identify differences between ways of life at different times.
